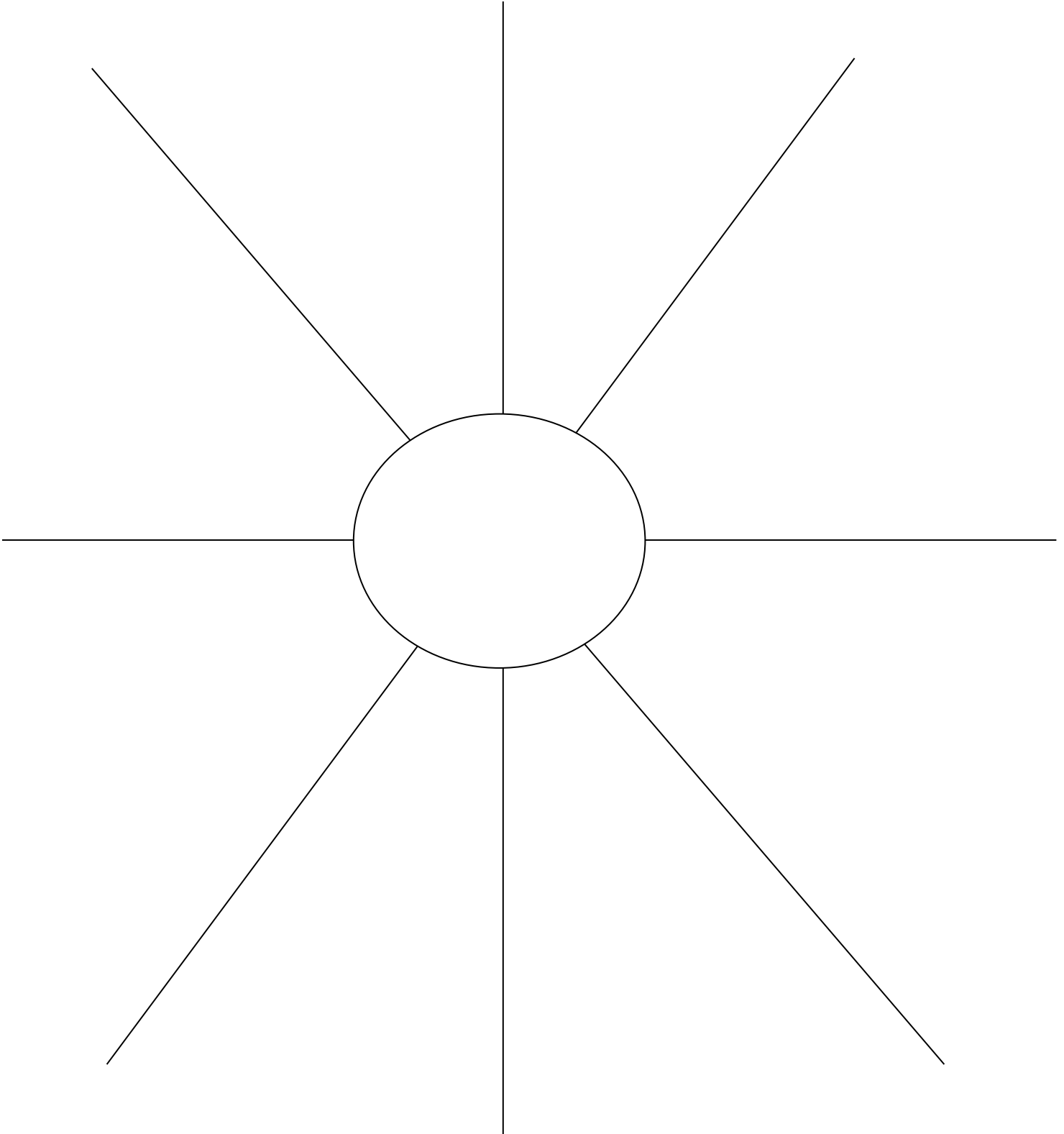


Research Web Organizer
